CARE OF YOUR INCISION

- (1) Your incision may be covered with a small sterile dressing, or some incisions on the head and neck area are left open.
- (2) You may clean the incision line with hydrogen peroxide 2 or 3 times a day for the first 2 days.
- (3) Place a small amount of Polysporin ointment on the incision line following the cleansing.
- (4) You may shower and get all incision lines wet 24 hours following the procedure unless otherwise instructed.
- (5) Most biopsy sites or surgical incisions heal uneventfully, but if you have what you think is an undue amount of pain or if there is the appearance of some redness or pronounced swelling 2 to 3 days following the procedure, please contact us.
- (6) Visible sutures are typically removed anywhere from 5 to 10 days following the procedure, depending on the type of wound closure and the location. I for some reason a follow up appointment was not made at the time of your visit, please contact us to make appropriate arrangements.
