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REDUCTION MAMMOPLASTY

A **Reduction Mammoplasty** is a beneficial surgery to reduce the size of your breasts and decrease back pain, neck pain, shoulder pain and rashes under the breasts.

Pre-operative Instructions

- 1. Do not take aspirin or anti-inflammatory medications for 10 days before surgery as this may increase the risk of bleeding. Tylenol is acceptable.
- 2. If your surgery is done as an outpatient, you will be given prescriptions that need to be filled in advance. Do not take them until after your operation.
- 3. Prior to your surgery date, purchase an inexpensive, stretchy bra. Something that offers support but avoid anything with under wires or that is too tight.
- 4. If you are going home the day of surgery you will need a driver and someone to take care of you the first 48 hours.

Post-operative instructions

- 1. You may be in the hospital 1-2 days. You may have drains and will be instructed at the hospital on care, emptying, etc.
- 2. Notify the doctor if any of the following occur:
 - Temperature over 101 degrees or chills
 - If a drain bulb completely fills after emptying and/or dressings are sloppy wet with blood.
- 3. You may shower the next day after drains have been removed.
- 4. For the first few days you may shower and clean the incisions as needed with soap and water. Then cover with small amount of ointment, gauze dressings and a supportive wrap. You may experience some oozing from incisions for one to two weeks. This is normal.
- 5. It is common to experience swelling and discomfort. Do not apply ice packs or heating pads to the breast.
- 6. Take medications with food to decrease stomach upsets. If narcotics cause nausea and/or vomiting, discontinue use and try Ibuprofen or Aleve.
- 7. It is O.K. to use Ibuprofen or Aleve in between doses of other pain medications. Try to wait at least two hours between any medication doses.
- 8. You may begin driving when you are no longer taking narcotics.
- 9. Avoid lifting objects 10 pounds or more, and avoid strenuous activities for 2 weeks after surgery.
- 10. Make a follow up appointment for 7-10 days following surgery.
